 - Construction update: Gym is closed for 2 weeks to finish the gym: 2 basketball nets, finish flooring, baseboards, paint lines, padding up on walls, scoreboard and electricity, dividing curtains.
 - Black Top: painted parking lot and blacktop
 - Upgrades: Creative playgrounds (back of gym: basketball court, 3 games for younger children, 4 squares redone, game in corner by new build and grassy area, hop scotch, paint designs around line up areas) to be done in the spring once the build is done.
 - Playground equipment is coming and admin will have the children, counsel and parents will all vote on what we order. This will all be done in the Spring
